Aquatic Transformers

Azola is a super villian fern. It is often confused with another villian known as Duckweed until it turns red. They are both very deceptive because these mats start out small and harmless looking and soon transform into an alien invasion.

Both invaders, Azola and Duckweed, can be found in ponds, canals, ditches, marshes and in protected areas of rivers and lakes.

- Small leaf-like stems are called fronds.
- Fronds are usually 1/16 by 1/16 of an inch
- The fronds grow together and form mats.
- In areas where there are several mats, winds will push the mats to one side of the waterway where they become one large mat. Within a few months the entire waterway will become covered.
- Mats can grow up to 1 inch thick
- Heavy growth can harm the natural aquatic system by lowering the levels of sunlight and oxygen.
- Duckweed has flowers but they are seldom ever seen.
- They reproduce by budding and by seeds. The seeds are carried from lake to lake by birds, ducks, frogs and alligators.
